INSTRUCTIONS TO RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE
INSTITUTIONS ON PROPER OPERATION UNDER EXEMPTION STATUTES:

The Certificate of Exemption enclosed, herewith, authorizes you to purchase tangible personal property for your own use and consumption free from Sales or Use Tax. You are required to furnish your vendor a properly executed Certificate of Exemption showing the number on the Certificate issued to you in order that the records of the vendor will be such as to justify his reporting sales made to you. A supply of forms for your use is being mailed to you by separate cover.

The exemption granted by law to religious, educational and charitable institutions is on sales made direct to such institutions and does not apply to sales made to allied organizations or anyone doing work for you. Church auxiliaries, or other such allied organizations are not exempt from Sales and Use Tax, but the church itself may make any purchases for such organizations.

Where you operate as both a consumer and a vendor of tangible personal property, you must collect Sales Tax on tangible personal property sold and remit it to this Department. In some instances, this will require a registration with this Division; for instance, a hospital selling medicine or food to patients must collect tax thereon; a school which furnishes room and board to its students must collect tax on the amount charged for board; a school operating a cafeteria or supply room must collect and remit tax on sales made through these channels.

Institutions making a large volume of purchases are given authority to execute a Blanket Certificate of Exemption to each vendor covering all purchases which they may make from such vendor. Institutions making only occasional purchases are given authority to execute a Unit Certificate of Exemption which must carry the dollar amount of the purchase; a separate form must accompany every purchase order made under a Unit Certificate.

APPLICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP AND FOR ELECTRIC SERVICE

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby applies for membership in, and agrees to purchase electric energy from Caney Fork Electric Cooperative, Inc., (hereinafter called the "Cooperative"), upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant will pay to the Cooperative the sum of \$5.00, which if this application is accepted by the Cooperative, will constitute the Applicant's membership fee.
2. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative all electric energy used on the premises described below and will pay therefor monthly at rates to be determined from time to time in accordance with the bylaws of the Cooperative; provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy which it shall be required to furnish to the Applicant. The Applicant will pay a bill of at least \$ 3.50 per month regardless of the number of kilowatt hours consumed.
3. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative. The Applicant's house is approximately _____ feet from the proposed distribution line, and _____ feet from the nearest public road.
4. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the articles of incorporation, the articles of conversion, and by laws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
5. The Applicant, by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law his private property is exempt from execution for any such debts or liabilities.

The acceptance of this application by the Cooperative shall constitute an agreement between the Applicant and the Cooperative, and the contract for electric service shall continue in force for Five years from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the Applicant, and thereafter until cancelled by at least 30 days' written notice given by either party to the other.

Notwithstanding anything herein contained the Applicant expressly agrees that the Cooperative may, prior to the acceptance of this application, use the \$5.00 for the development of a rural electrification project. If the Cooperative is unable to obtain a loan from the Rural Electrification Administration to finance the construction of such a project, the Applicant agrees that only so much of the \$5.00 as has not yet been expended for development expenses will be returned to him. If the Cooperative succeeds in establishing a rural electrification project but is unable to furnish service to the Applicant, the sum of \$5.00 will be returned to the Applicant.
