These things we do Covenant and agree to observe to keep Sacred in the name of and by the assistance of the Trinity Amen. Abstract

- 1st) We believe in the being of God as almighty Eternal Unchangeable of Infinite wisdom Power justice Holiness goodness; Mercy and faith; and that this God has Revealed himself in his word under the character of Father Son and Holyghost.
- 2nd) We believe that Almighty God has made known his mind and will to the Children of Men in his word which word we believe to be of Divine authority and contains all things necessary to be known for the Satisfaction of man & woman. The same we comprehend or contains the Book of the Old and New Testament.
- 3rd) We believe that God before the foundation of the World for a purpose of his own Glory did Elect a certain number of Men & Angels to Eternal life and that this Election is Particular Eternal and unchangeable on the creatures Part.
- 4th) We believe when God made men at first he made them in his own Image in his own likeness and he stood as a federal Head or a Representation of all his natural offsprings.
- 5th) We believe that Adam fell from this State of Innocent Rectitude and that he involved himself and all his offsprings

ina State of Death; and for that Original transgression, we all are both filthy and guilty in the site of an holy God.

- 6th) We believe that it is utterly out of the power of men as fallen creatures to keep the Laws of God perfectly as part of their lives truly or believe in Christ. Except they be drawn by the Holy Spirit.
- 7th) We believe that in Gods own appointed time and way by means which he has ordained the Elect shall be called justified pardoned and sanctified; and that it is Impossible they can utterly refuse the call but shall be made willing by Divine grace to receive the offer of Mercy.
- 8th) We believe that justification in the site of God is only but the Imputed Righteousness of Jesus Christ received and applied by Faith alone.
- 9th) We believe in like manner that Gods Elect shall not only be called and justified but they shall be converted borned again and changed by the Effectual workings of Gods holy Spirit.
- 10th) We believe that such as are called converted and justified by his grace shall persevere in holiness and never fall finally away.
- 11th) We believe it to be a duty Encumbent on all Gods people to walk Religiously in Gods word; not in the old Covenant way of sealing life and the favor of the Lord by it but only as a duty from a principal of love.
- 12th) We believe Baptism and the Lords supper are Gospel ordinances both belonging to the converted or true believers and that persons who were or dipped whilst in unbelief were not Regularly Baptized according to Gods word.

And that such ought to be Baptised after
they are savingly converted in to the
Faith of Christ —

13) We believe that Every Church is Inde-
pendent in Matters of discipline
and that Associations counsels and confer-
ences of several Ministers or Churches are not
to impose on the Churches the keeping
holding or maintaining any principal
or practice contrary to the Churches judgment

14th) We believe in the Resurrection of the
dead both of the just and the unjust
and a General Judgment

15) We believe that the punishment of
the Wicked is everlasting, and the joys
of the Righteous are Eternal —

16) We believe that no Minister has a right
to the Ordinance of the Administrations
only such as are regularly called
and come under the imposition
of hands by the Presbytery

17) And lastly we do believe further Mutual
Comfort Union, and satisfaction of the
several Churches of the afore said faith
and order that we ought to meet in an
Associations way wherein each Church
ought right Represent their Case by their
Delegates and attend as after as is necessary
to advise with the several Churches
in conference and that the Dissision of
matters in such Associations not to be
imposed on in any wise binding on the
Churches without their consent but to
only set and act as an advising Council

Rules of the church Aug 19-1909

- 1st. We believe that the church militant are composed of men and women possessing their faith in the doctrine advocated and taught by said believers.
- Second that they are bound together by love and fellowship.
- Third, that they are to watch over each other for good to the honor and glory of god and the comfort and happiness of said church.
- Fourth church has a right to select their pasture and peace and they ought to use consideration of the same.
- Fifth, and they should be subject to the church and not lord it over god's heritage.
- Sixth, when a member male or female is quarreled with another and has taken the brethren in the 18 of Matthew and Luke the 17 and they fail to comply with the same they should be dealt with by the church according to the judgment of the church.
- Seventh, if any member fails to attend his or her church meeting more than three meetings and cannot show a just cause for so doing they may be subject to sentence of the church.
- Eighth, no member should absent his or her self from the communion table with out giving a just cause for so doing.

- Ninth, member male or female who has been excluded from any other church for any cause and present selves to this church for membership should be refused until they are restored to their former church and come with a letter.

- Thirteenth, any quarrel desiring to speak should arise and address the moderator.
- fourteenth, peace and harmony should be aimed at all times.
- Fifteenth, this church should select a moderator and clearly from its own body, and it shall be the moderator duty to put all questions to this body when properly brought before the church and the duty of the clerk is to keep a true record of all transactions of the same.
